Presentation should be about 15 min long (15 slides max) and should include following contents:

• Background information

- o Explain the background information relevant to your project.
- o Here, you are most likely referring to information you obtained from other sources. Every time you use ideas & images, you need to indicate the source information on that slide (not at the end). The source information should include author name, journal title, volume number, page number, publication year)
- The project goal
- **Objectives** (specific research plans)
- **Research Progress** (what you've done so far)
 - o Present data & your interpretation.
 - o Although it is always good to show positive data, don't be afraid to present negative data if that's all you have. In that case, provide explanations why it may not have worked and how you will be dealing with the problem in the future.
 - o If you are presenting somebody else's data, make sure to acknowledge that person in the slide and in your explanation.
- Future plan (what you will do for the rest of the term)
- Acknowledgment

Please bring your presentation file at least 15 min before the presentation. Your file will be loaded onto my laptop (PC) so that presentations can begin immediately. Please save your file as a PowerPoint file. In addition, please create a PDF file as a backup.

Your presentation should be followed by 5 min question period.
